To thoroughly rebuild a forklift engine, a good company will initially entirely disassemble it. A heat cleaning system is then utilized to clean all of the parts. Once this step has been done, all of the parts are checked to see if they have any extensive wear, any defects or breakage. Particular components like for example crankshafts, cylinder blocks, connecting rods and cylinder heads are resurfaced, resized and reground if necessary. Other components like bolts, gears, nuts and so on. are repaired or replaced as needed.

As soon as the overhaul has been done, the engine is rebuilt by hand. After being put back together, a series of tests are applied to the working machinery to be able to check all of the parts and be positive there are no leaks or problems. If any problems occur, the necessary adjustments are done.
